**A RESOLUTION OF THE SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT, SUPPORTING SNOQUALMIE VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT #410 PROPOSITIONS 1 AND 2 TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS ON FEBRUARY 9, 2010.**

WHEREAS, the Snoqualmie Valley School District #410 is submitting two measures to the voters in February of 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Si View Metropolitan Park District held a public hearing on January 20, 2010 to receive public testimony relating to the Snoqualmie Valley School District #410 Levy Measures; and

WHEREAS, Proposition 1, a renewal of the Maintenance and Operation Levy that allows the School District the ability to make up the funding difference between what the School District receives from the State of Washington and the Federal Government and what is required to fund the programs currently offered in our schools; Proposition 2, a renewal of the Technology Levy which provides financial means to replace existing "outdated" technology, enhance classroom technologies and improve emergency communications and safety systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE SI VIEW METROPOLITAN PARK DISTRICT, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Si View Metropolitan Park District Board of Commissioners hereby formally supports the following Snoqualmie Valley School District #410's Levy Measures with respect to February 9, 2010 ballot:


- Proposition 1: Renewal Maintenance and Operation Levy
